Easter Sunday, 31st March 2024

Easter offers hope to all who are oppressed, broken and hopeless. God's grace and mercy can bring new life into any situation no matter how difficult it may seem. Easter encourages us to make new beginnings, to turn over the page and to break out in new directions. Blessed John Henry Newman said, *"to live is to change"* and this time of the year, the new growth of Springtime, encourages us to turn over a new leaf and to start afresh. In our Gospel today, we are told about the dramatic discovery of the empty tomb by Mary of Magdala. When she made her way to the tomb on that first Easter morning, she was doing so in order to complete the

Jewish burial customs. And, initially, she did not realise that Jesus has risen from the dead. We are told that: *Mary of Magdala came to the tomb. She saw that the stone had been moved away from the tomb and came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved. 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb' she said 'and we don't know where they have put him.'* Saint John Paul II paid great attention to the particular role of Saint Mary Magdalene as the first witness who saw the risen Christ, and as the first messenger who announced the Lord's resurrection to the Apostles. The Season of Easter lasts for fifty days between Easter Sunday and Pentecost and is slightly longer than the Season of Lent which has just concluded. Let us celebrate Easter with those we meet especially those who may need inspiration and encouragement. Our Easter joy is based on the fact that we believe that the risen Lord, who stood among his disciples on that first Easter morning, also stands among us today. I would like to wish you, your families, friends and neighbours a very happy and peaceful Easter.
